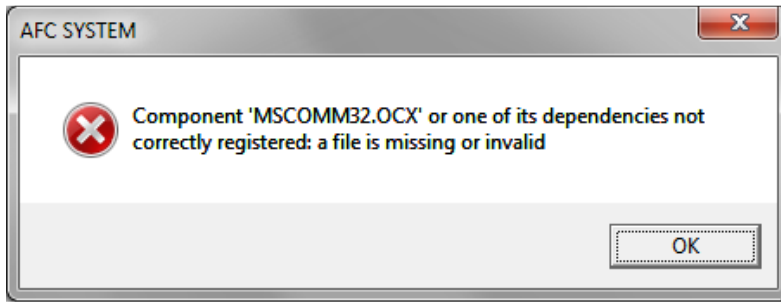




Installing AFC Software on Windows 10 both 32 and 64 bit editions.

When installing AFC / DSP software onto a computer running Windows 10, the following error may come up when you try to launch the program.




The first time you run the AFC / DSP software in Windows 10, you need to *right* click on the AFC / DSP launch icon and select “Run as Administrator” along the bottom of the screen. This will register the AFC

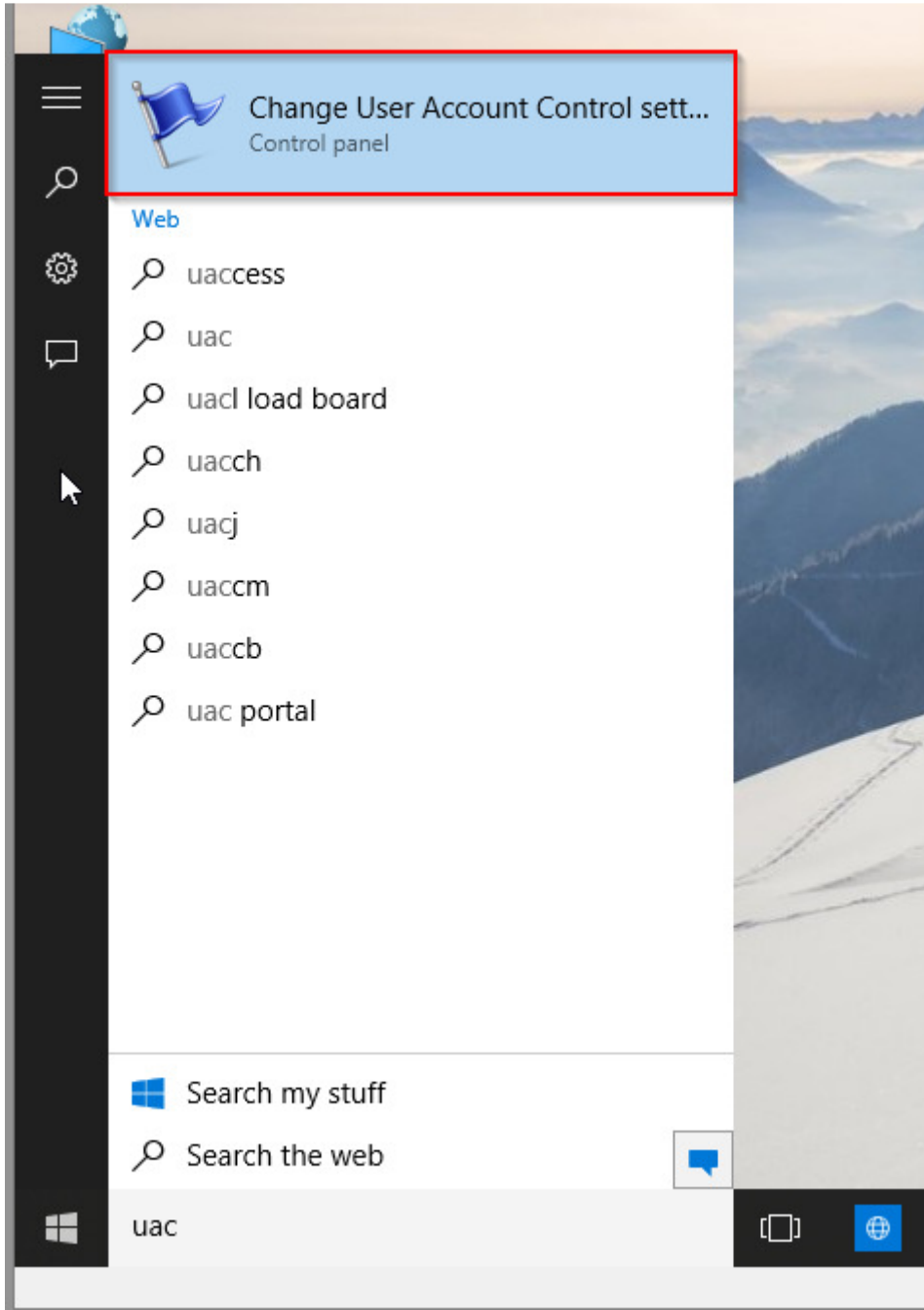
software files necessary to run the next time you launch the software. Once you do this, it should run as normal.





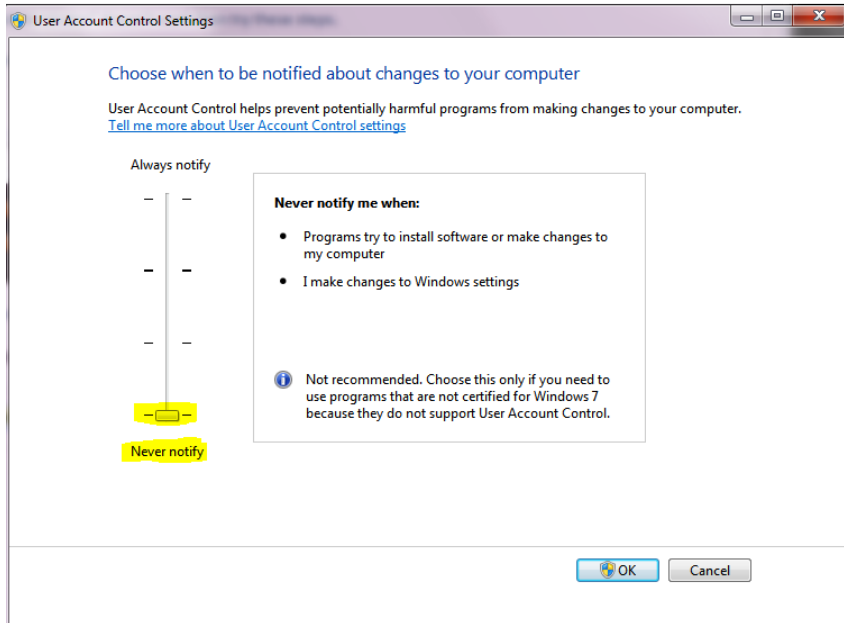
IMPORTANT: The following steps are REQUIRED for all AFC/DSP software besides the AFC3000 system. If these steps are not completed the “FASTENING DATA MONITOR” icon will not work.

Click the windows button  on your keyboard and then in the search box type ‘uac’. At the top of list click “Change User Account Control settings.”





Once in UAC settings screen make a note of where the slider bar is set at. Typically it's one click down from the top. Change this to the bottom by dragging the bar to the bottom setting of 'Never notify'.



This procedure used to require a reboot but Windows 10 does not require a reboot. You need to *right* click on the AFC / DSP launch icon and select "Run as Administrator". If the errors are gone you should change the UAC setting back to its previous setting and click OK. Verify that the AFC or DSP software now runs properly without any errors.

IF the error still persists we recommend turning the UAC setting back to 'Never notify', and then try to uninstall then reinstall the software. *Right* click on the AFC / DSP launch icon and select "Run as Administrator". If this works, set UAC back to its previous setting and click OK. Verify once again if the AFC or DSP software runs without error.
